### *Cinderella*



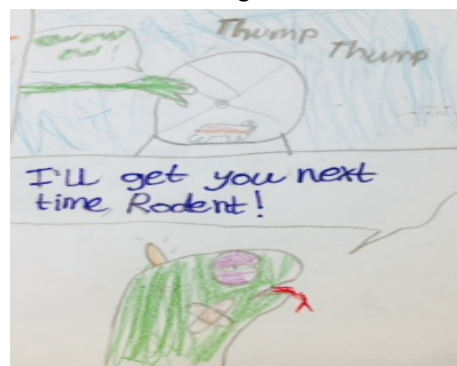
