Molly's Candy Apples!

Ingredients:

6 apples

1 cup of white sugar

1/2 of unsalted butter

1/2 a cup of dark corn syrup

3/4 of a cup of heavy Whipping cream

1 tbs of dark molasses

1 tbs of vanilla extract

Instructions:

Place sugar, butter, cream, corn syrup, molasses, vanilla, and salt

In a saucepan and stir on a medium low to medium heat. Until the sugar has dissolved. Leave the caramel cool to under 200F while it is cooling insert the sticks in the apples. Dip the apples in the caramel and let the excess caramel drip off and put them on a tray with greaseproof paper on it. Let them cool and

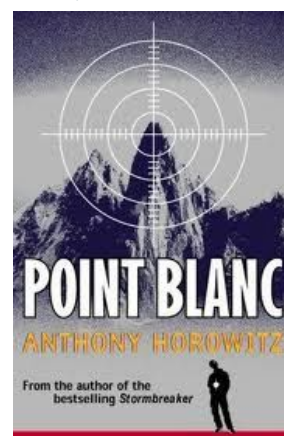
Book Review!
