11.Did you always want to teach?


Yes. Ever since I was a little girl I never considered another career. It was all I ever wanted to do.

Chicken & Broccoli Bake



<u>Ingredients:</u>

I full head of Broccoli

3-4 breasts of chicken

I can of condensed chicken soup

1 heaped tablespoon of mayonnaise

A pinch of curry powder

4 oz of wholemeal breadcrumbs

4 oz of grated cheddar cheese

2 oz of butter (melted)

Method:

- 1. Put the chicken breasts into a saucepan of cold water. Bring to boil, then simmer for 15-20 mins until cooked. Drain and cut into bite size pieces.
- 2. Put the broccoli into a pot of water and bring to a simmer for 5 minutes. Cool and cut into florets.
- 3. Preheat the oven to 190 degrees.
